

the recruitment process:

PRESCREENING INTERVIEW WITH AMPLIA

Face-to-face or online interview with Amplia's consultants:

introduction to our H2B Recruitment Program; sharing expectations; analysis of the candidate's career path and motivations; outlining the next steps of the process.

INTERVIEW WITH THE COUNTRY CLUB

Either face-to-face or online, in both cases attended by the club's representatives.

HIRING PROCESS

After receiving a formal offer letter, you'll be expected to:

- . start your H2B visa request process(1);
- . produce your Criminal Records(2);
- . produce a copy of your Passport⁽³⁾;
- . undergo medical exams arranged by Amplia;
- (1) the cost of the process \$190 USD will be reimbursed along with your first salary in the US
- (2) the cost around €5 in Portugal; €20 in Italy will be reimbursed along with your first salary in the US
- (3) your passport should be valid at least until the end of the season you're applying in

H2B VISA: valid for one year, renewable for up to three years.

Face-to-face interview appointments should be made with the American Embassy in Portugal (Lisbon) or in Italy - either with the Embassy, in Rome, or with the Milan, Florence or Naples Consulate General.

REQUISITES

- . European nationality (EU passport holder), preferably;
- . Training in the context of the tasks to be performed (ideally, Hospitality School):
- . On-the-job experience, or related experience, in costumer service;
- . Internships will qualify as job experience;
- . Good English level (disqualifying factor);
- . Availability to remain in Florida for the full 8 months of the program;
- . Excellent communication and teamwork skills;
- . Positive attitude and a dynamic personality.

GENERAL BENEFITS

- . Travel to and from the US paid by the employer (at the beginning and the end of the season);
- . Airport transfers provided by the employer;
- . Daily commute, from the staff accommodation to the workplace, provided by each country club;
- . Visa (\$190) and Criminal Records costs (€5, if requested in Portugal: €20, if requested in Italy) reimbursed in your first salary in the US;
- . Meals on duty (for the F&B staff);
